

Fully re-opening

The latest Government advice is that by **July 19** we should be fully open.

At all times we should operate in a COVID-19 secure manner, observing Hands –Face – Space. We should wear masks when passing through the corridor areas; sanitise our hands; follow the one way system (entering by front door, exiting by garden door); and ensure only one person at a time on the stairs. Everyone should download the NHS app to their mobiles and scan the QR code (near sanitising stations) every visit. Groups should keep rooms ventilated by opening windows and leaving doors open.

Please give the office as much notice as possible of your intention to return, so that we can ensure that you are fully briefed on our protocols as well as making any minor adjustments to booking times to keep all Yewsers safe.
